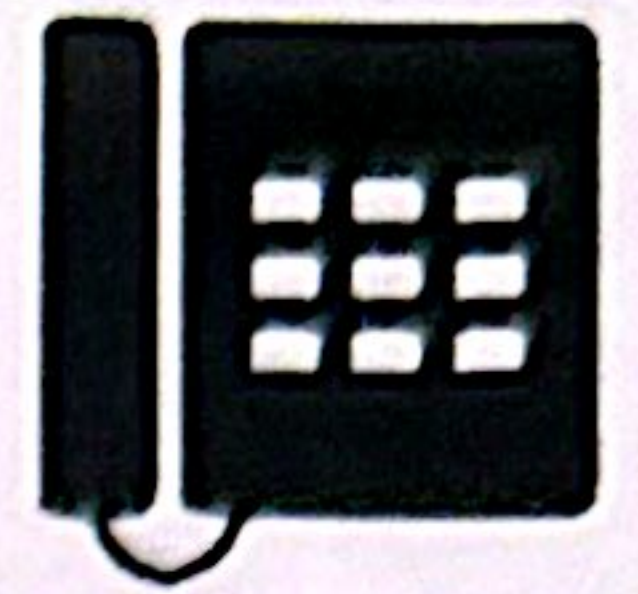

**Workplace Labor Law Posting Requirement**

Failure to display the required federal and state labor law notices may result in penalties or fines. Pursuant to federal regulations, including 29 U.S.C. §666(i), non-compliance with posting requirements may subject employers to enforcement actions and potential legal liability.

Employers must ensure that all required labor law posters are displayed in a conspicuous location within the workplace where employees and job applicants can easily view them.

Congratulations on registering your new business! **YOU MAY STILL HAVE SOME ITEMS PENDING.** This letter is intended to inform you about important documents which may still be required to operate your business. The documents listed below are not the same as registering your business and may require additional steps.

EIN (Tax ID)

- Employer Identification Number, also called a Federal Tax ID, is a 9-digit number associated with your business and is issued by the IRS.
- **All businesses are required to register** with the federal government and obtain an EIN\*. Fines can be up to \$10,000.
- An EIN is also required to hire employees, open a business bank account, file taxes, apply for business loans / lines of credit, and other business purposes.

Labor Law Posters

- State and Federal law mandates employment posters be displayed which inform employees of their rights under the NRA (National Labor Relations Act).
- **It is required by Federal & State Law** for these poster to be posted in a visible location of the workplace for businesses with at least one employee. Penalties and fines can be upward of \$25,000 and lead to potential lawsuits.

Certificate of Status

- Certifies that your company is in existence & authorized to transact business in the state of Indiana.
- This certificate may be required for loans, to renew business licenses, to open your business bank account, to register an Indiana formed company as foreign entity in another state, and/or other business purposes.
